

> 05-VIII : Grievance Redressal mechanism for Faculty, staff and students

Faculty meetings are held on a regular basis in each department, chaired by the corresponding HOD. The faculty's difficulties, if any, with administrative and academic grievances are discussed in meetings, and the responsible HODs attempt to resolve these issues at the departmental level, but may occasionally submit the situation to the principal, depending on the degree of the problem.Staff grievances, if any, are forwarded to the Registrar and Principal for resolution.

Students' problems are addressed through the required system, which entails a staff member serving as a mentor for approximately 15-20 students. Academic difficulties encountered by students are addressed by subject instructors in cooperation with HODs. Other minor issues concerning students, if any, are sent to the college administration via suggestion boxes, and appropriate procedures for redressing these grievances are taken at the appropriate level.
