The Creative Storytelling Prompt Challenge

Movie *The Boy Who Harnessed the Wind* was organized at Smt. Indira Gandhi College of Engineering, Ghansoli, on 28th October, 2024 from 1:00 PM-3:00 PM in Electrical/Mechanical Class (First floor). The screening of *The Boy Who Harnessed the Wind* was organized to inspire and educate attendees on the themes of resilience, innovation, and the power of education. Based on the true story of William Kamkwamba from Malawi, the film chronicles the journey of a young boy who builds a wind turbine to combat drought and famine in his village.

The primary objectives of the event were: A) To Inspire Through Real-Life Innovation: Highlight William’s story of using limited resources and self-taught engineering skills to solve a critical problem. B) To Promote Discussion on Resilience and Education: Encourage reflection on the importance of persistence, education, and creativity in overcoming challenges. C) To Raise Awareness of Global Issues: Increase understanding of the impact of drought, poverty, and resource scarcity on communities worldwide.

The discussion generated several insights: A) Empathy and Global Awareness: Attendees expressed a deeper understanding of the challenges faced by communities in resource-limited areas. B) Value of Education: Many were inspired by how William’s determination to learn independently transformed his community, emphasizing the empowering nature of education. C) Innovation and Resourcefulness: The film underscored the idea that innovation can emerge from any circumstance, inspiring participants to think creatively about problem-solving in their own contexts.

The movie event successfully achieved its goals, leaving attendees with a sense of inspiration and a renewed appreciation for the importance of resilience and creativity. *The Boy Who Harnessed the Wind* proved to be a powerful narrative that resonated with participants, highlighting how one individual’s determination can drive significant change. The event fostered meaningful discussion and motivated participants to think about the impact of education and ingenuity in addressing both local and global challenges.
